COMMODORE'S COMMENTS

Our annual compliance inspection by the Corps of Engineers is in for the 2016 year and includes good news along with some future challenges for us. Thank you everyone for the work in the park and on the docks last year, it was appreciated by the Corps and noted as being "neat and tidy" with no deficiencies. They also noted the addition of roller guides at the pilings to increase their efficiency and extend the life of the aging pilings.

Future challenges for us include upgrading our docks and deck boards to the same type as we have on the pump out dock at a cost of about 5

times the 2"x6" lumber we use now. Milfoil was also discussed and noted to be a problem at all the Corps leases in the area with no immediate solution available yet.

I recommend that all the other Captains in the club make a copy of this report as I did (see page 2). I find it useful to remind Lisa occasionally that the United States Army Corps of Engineers has documented that I am "neat and tidy " in spite of her sometimes contrary opinion of me.

ARTICLE II - GOVERNING BODY

EXISTING:

Section 12. PAYMENT OF THE GOVERNING BODY. (added 9-13-09)

- a. The Officers of the Governing Body, who in compensation for services performed, shall each be credited one-half of their annual regular membership dues. (added 9-13-09)
- b. Payment shall be effective 1 January 2010. (added 9-13-09)

ADD:

- c. Members of the board, who in compensation for services performed, shall each be credited one-fourth of their annual regular membership dues. (added 3-26-17)
- d. Payment shall be effective 1 January 2017. (added 3-26-17)


SAILBOAT RACING
