

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION
JANUARY 1 THROUGH DECEMBER 31

Conditions of Application:

1. It is allowable establish a dual membership at the point of joining the club.
2. At the New Membership Orientation, both applicants must be in attendance. A dual membership applicant cannot join without the dual co-member being present.
3. Each dual member must have submitted an application.
4. An offered membership must be accepted within 10 days from date of offer.
5. Balance of dues and fees is due no later than 10 days after acceptance before the next applicant will be contacted.
6. Proof of liability insurance in the amount of \$300,000 must be submitted within 10 days. Each applicant shall provide separate proof of liability insurance.
7. An application can be accepted without owning a boat. However, an applicant who currently has a boat will be considered a priority over an applicant without a boat.
8. If either member of a dual membership wishes to apply for separate moorage, there shall be a waiting period of 12 months after the establishment of the dual membership before either dual membership is eligible to make this change. (added 6-26-11) This requires the original membership to retain the membership during this 12 month time frame.
9. Updating your application: You must advise the club if you have a different boat than the boat listed on your application. You must also advise the club if you have a change in phone numbers.

Annual Repair and Maintenance Fee

This fee may be credited at \$20.00 per hour for each hour worked with the approval of the Commodore.
 There are 25 work hours per membership/year required. If no hours are worked, total billed will be \$500.
 (Any hours not worked will be billed at \$20/hour, payable no later than November 30th, without incurring a late fee of \$25.)
 This balance will be billed in November of each year

Late Fee

(Late fees are applied to all billings not paid after 30 days net from receipt of statement)
 (Exception: Bills due January 1 **MUST BE PAID in full NLT February 28.** Otherwise a reinstatement fee may apply)
 (Exception: Bills due July 1 **MUST BE PAID in full NLT August 20.** Otherwise a reinstatement fee may apply)

Conditions of Moorage:

- >> Moorage is not transferable with the sale of a boat or boathouse.
- >> Annual moorage fees and membership fees are **not prorated** in any manner.
- >> **The Board of Directors reserves the right to rearrange moorage.**
- >> The calendar year is from January 1 through December 31.
- >> The fiscal year is from April 1st of the current year and ends the following year on March 31.
- >> The work hour year begins on November 1st of the current fiscal year and ends the following October 31st.

The above fees are as stated in the WWYC Bylaws, revised March 31, 2021.

Assessments: If there is an assessment in effect at time of membership, you will be required to contribute the same amount as the regular membership.
