STANDING RULES

G. **GROUND RULES** (revised 2-10-15) **(revised 10-9-18)**

1. **Grounds:** (added 2-10-15)

- a. Fires are allowed only in the established campfire area, the rolling fire pit or in propane pits.
- b. Campers are responsible for taking all of their personal garbage to the club dumpster.
- c. RV's and personal vehicles must be located to insure access and egress by other campers and club members.
- d. Pets must be restrained or "at heel" at all times. Campers are responsible to clean up after their pets.
- e. Any damage to, or problems in the campground is to be reported to the **Commodore.**

2. **Parking:** (revised_02-10-2015) **(revised 10-9-18)**

- a. Do not block loading areas near the clubhouse or boat ramps. Vehicles shall not remain at loading areas any longer than necessary to load and unload.
- b. Boat trailers will be parked in a designated parking area. **Do not park on the lawn across from the mobile home.**
- c. Boat trailers on the WWYC grounds shall be **marked, labeled, or tagged** with the owner's name on the tongue or near the hitch in such a manner that remains legible for as long as the owner intends to or park the trailer there. **The Vice Commodore will assist and monitor this.** (added 2/12/02) **(revised 10-9-18)**

D. **RESERVATION RULES:** **(revised 9/18/18)**

1. **Guidelines for Making a Reservation:**

- a. Reservations are made for the convenience of the membership. **The Secretary will schedule use of the clubhouse, park grounds, or RV sites so that there are no conflicts with other members for the same time.**
- b. **All reservations (clubhouse, park ground or RV sites) must be applied for by contacting the Secretary by email.** You need to provide the date(s) you would like reserved.
- c. **Requested site(s) will be assigned a location, as available. They may not necessarily be adjacent.**
- d. The Secretary will notify you if your request is approved. All reservations must be requested **at least 10 days in advance, no exceptions.** This allows the membership to be notified in time to plan their use accordingly. The secretary will notify the membership by group email.
- e. Reservations will only be accepted **from May 1 through September 30.**
- f. Reservations will not be accepted **5 days before or 5 days after these holidays: Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day.**
- g. **The sponsoring member, who requests the reservation,** must be present at all scheduled events. This member assumes all responsibility for any liability incurred to their guests and their property and relieves the Walla Walla Yacht Club, its Board of Directors, and members from any liability whatsoever.

2. **Clubhouse:** **(revised 10-9-18)**

- a. **Follow reservation procedures listed in Reservation Rules, D.1. In addition to the date requested, provide the times for anticipated use.**
- b. Private use **of the clubhouse** cannot conflict with regularly scheduled club activities, including (but not restricted to) regular membership, board meetings, or club sponsored events.
- c. The use of the clubhouse is intended for members and their family and guests. There is no charge to the membership for reserving the clubhouse.
- d. Clubhouse use is for the **main club room only.**
- e. Reservations do not include the kitchen counter seating. That area is for the members use during your reserved time.
- f. The kitchen facilities are to be shared during meal preparation. This includes the use of the 2 BBQ's. Clean the BBQ's up immediately after use.
- g. Please provide your own paper plates, plastic silverware, etc. Also, please provide any condiments you may

need. Plastic tablecloths are reserved for club use only.

3. **Park Grounds – Lawn area above Firepit: (revised 10-9-18)**

- a. **Follow procedures listed in Reservation Rules, D.1.**
- b. The park grounds may be reserved by members for weddings, reunions, retirements, and similar events.
- c. There is no charge to the membership for reserving the park grounds. Donations are appreciated.
- d. Park grounds reservations do not reserve the main clubroom, kitchen facilities or counter area for private use. You may use the kitchen on a limited basis; however, the kitchen facilities are to be shared with other members. This includes the use of the BBQ's. If you anticipate a need for reserving the main clubroom, please do this separately.
- e. Consider renting a porta-potty for the time you reserve, if you anticipate a large group.
- f. Please provide your own paper plates, plastic silverware, etc. Also, any condiments you may need. **Tables and chairs may not be moved from the clubhouse to the park.**

4. **Campground: (revised 10-9-18)**

- a. **Follow procedures listed in Reservation Rules, D.1.**
- b. The Ridder Campground is available to Walla Walla Yacht Club memberships and their accompanied guests only. It is not available to the public. There are twelve RV sites with full hookups but septic space is limited and waste disposal is to be minimized. Tent camping is permitted on the lawn area.
- c. **Length of stay is based on use from May 1 through September 30.**
 - 1) **Consecutive days campground extended use for regular/dual memberships is limited to 14 days, with a 7-day interval before another consecutive day use may start.**
 - 2) **Days use for associate and life members are limited to 14 days total, annually, with no extension. This 14-day limit is a combined limit for both moorage and camping and may be used individually.**
(Reference the Bylaws, Article VII, Section 3.)
- d. RV and tent sites are **available on a first come, first serve basis**, unless reserved for a special occasion/event. **Tent sites are not reserved.** Once established, an RV or tent site may not be left unattended overnight.
- e. **A maximum of five (5) RV sites may be reserved if you have guests.** You may include yourself within that number. **(Guests are also welcome, without reservations).**
- f. **Upon approval the secretary will notify you and the caretaker.** The caretaker will mark the number of requested sites with a reserved sign that includes the name of the member making the reservation and the dates of use. The caretaker will remove the signs following the end date.
